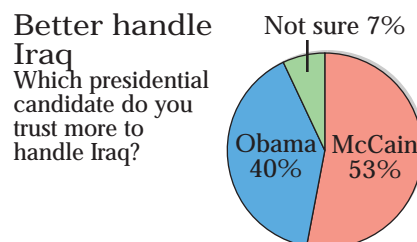
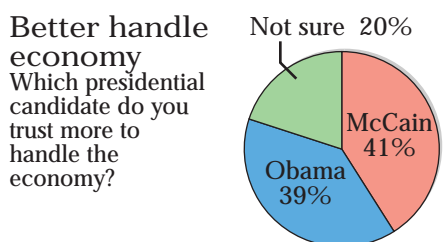
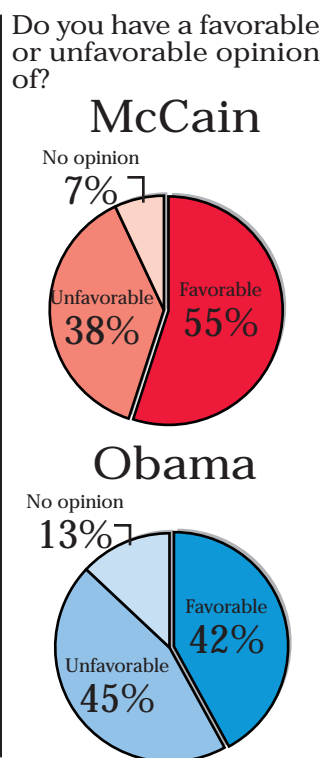
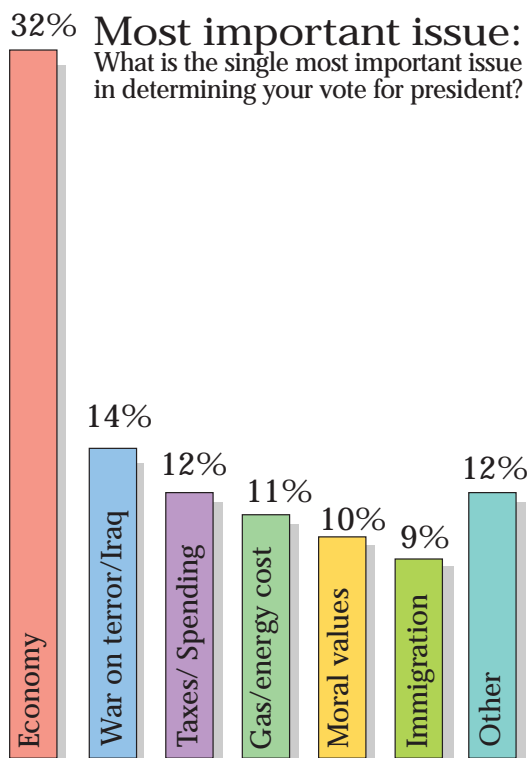
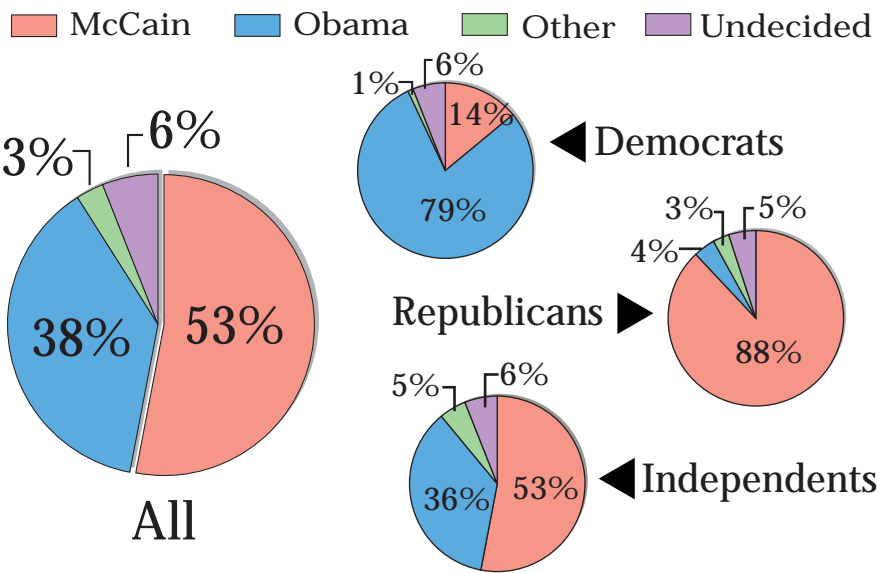


The News-Sentinel and News Channel 15 contracted with Research 2000, a nonpartisan polling firm based in Maryland, to conduct a pre-election survey in the 3rd Congressional District, which includes Fort Wayne. The polling company completed phone interviews with 600 likely voters, 48 percent men and 52 percent women, Oct. 16-18. Thirty percent of the respondents identified themselves as Democrats, 33 percent as Republicans and 37 percent as *in other.* The survey results have a margin of error of plus or minus 4 percentage points.

If the election for president were held today, would you vote for the Democrats ticket of Barack Obama and Joe Biden, the Republican ticket of John McCain and Sarah Palin, or another candidate?



About this survey: All polls are subject to sampling error, caused by the effects of chance. If this poll were repeated, 19 times out of 20 its results would accurately represent the likely voters of Fort Wayne to within 4 percentage points, plus or minus. For subgroups, such as men or Democrats, the margin of error is higher.
